The **Adopt-a-Portrait** program is an effort to more actively care for paintings in the collection of Pilgrim Hall Museum. When you become an adopter of a painting, you make a personal commitment to preserving our history for future generations. All contributions towards the adoption program are tax deductible. Adopters names will be included in exhibit signage when displayed (unless you would prefer otherwise).

Ten of the portrait paintings on display in *Scenes & Sitters* have been identified as the urgently in need of conservation treatment. Professional conservators have provided price estimates for these paintings. Some of the portraits are in greater need of conservation than others. Treatments will be based on the need of each individual painting, and could include cleaning, relining, removal of over-painting, and repair of the frames.

This is your chance to help Pilgrim Hall Museum sustain its commitment to stewardship by funding conservation treatment for these portraits.

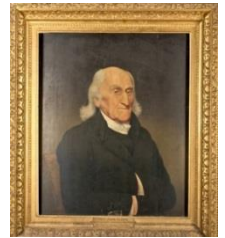
